

Veselinovič, Elvira. 2003. *Suppletion im irischen Verb* (Philologia - Sprachwissenschaftliche Forschungsergebnisse, 55). Hamburg: Verlag Dr. Kovač.

The book offers a synchronic and a diachronic picture of suppletion in the Irish verbal system from a typological perspective. The results of finding from both Indo-European and Celtic studies are used. Suppletion is viewed as a border case between grammar and lexicon. The book consists of four parts and a word list. In the beginning, the theoretical framework is set and discussed. A substantial part is devoted to verb compounding in old Irish. The following chapters give a detailed description of individual Irish suppletive verbs. The synchronic inspection of verbal suppletion in modern Irish follows. The last part gives an alphabetical list of the most important cases of old Irish suppletive verbs.
